

ICE HARBOR BREWERY POURS COYOTE CANYON MAMMOTH BREW TO BENEFIT MCBONES RESEARCH FOUNDATION.



"We like the idea that Coyote Canyon offers the community a hands on opportunity to participate in working science at the mammoth site, and that what is being taught as well as found is staying right here in our community.

MCBONES has given dozens of students the opportunity to pursue their interests in geology, paleontology and archeology without having to leave the Tri-Cities. As a volunteer organization there are financial needs for equipment and testing which we are proud to assist with through the sales of Mammoth Brew growlers and the seasonal beer on-tap at Ice Harbor throughout the dig season this year," said Mike Hall, Co-Owner of Ice Harbor Brewery.

While the 2015 "Dig Season" is running at the Coyote Canyon Mammoth site, Ice Harbor Brewery of Kennewick will be pouring Mammoth Brew from their seasonal tap and selling Mammoth Brew Growlers to benefit the Mid-Columbia Basin Old Natural Education Sciences (MCBONES) research foundation.

MCBONES promotes education and community involvement in the Coyote Canyon mammoth dig site with tours, field trips, internships and volunteer involvement in excavating the mammoth bones. Since 2008 CCMS has operated exclusively with community volunteers.

Full or empty growlers are available for purchase at Ice Harbor brewery for \$22.50 and \$10 respectively and Mammoth Brew seasonal beer is on tap at Ice Harbor Brewery's original downtown Kennewick location and the marina restaurants.
